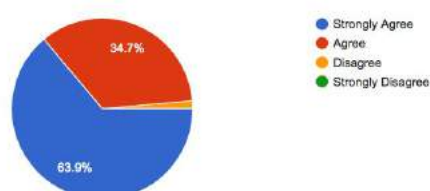

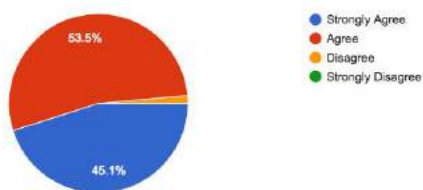

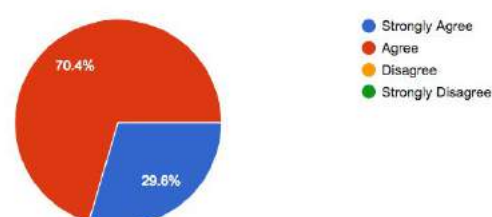

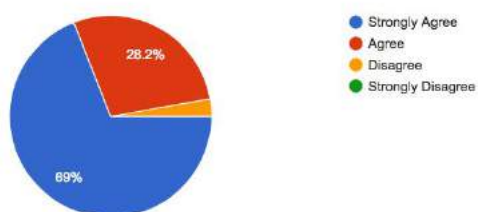

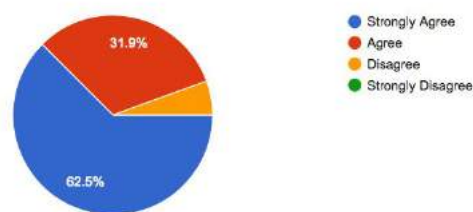

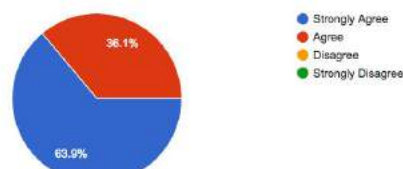

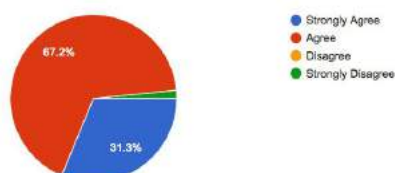

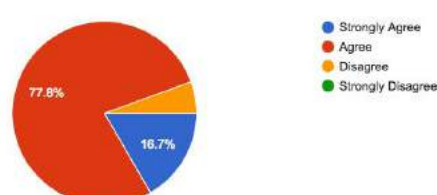

High School Musical Junior

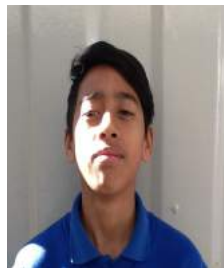

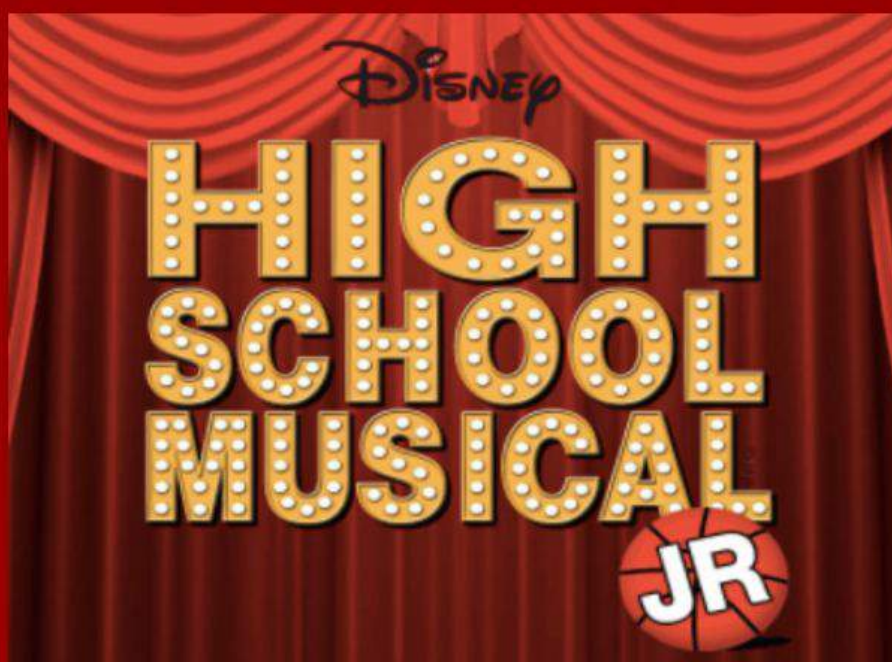
