On Thursday 21st of March we are holding our "Meet the Teacher" evening – 5:30 – 6:00.

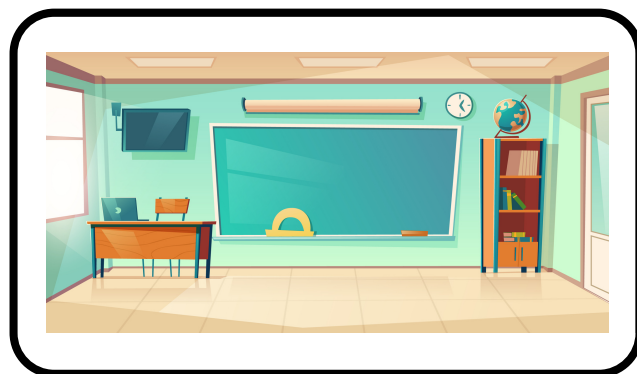
Please come and meet your child's teacher and get some information about the classroom schedules and programme. It is always good to put a face to the name.

- Your child will bring home a unique password a couple weeks after the school photoshoot.
- Simply visit our website [www.photosmart.co.nz](http://www.photosmart.co.nz) and click on **Online Ordering**.
- Orders placed before the Free Delivery Period expires will be delivered to the school a few weeks after the Free Delivery Period has closed.
- Digital files will be available to download earlier.

## **FAQS about PhotoSmart's Online Ordering Process**

### **1. When will my child's photos be ready to view online?**

Once you have received your Unique Password you can go online to view your child's photographs. Class Groups, Sports Groups, Additional Groups, and Portraits can be viewed using this code. You can also link other children to the one order by simply clicking on **Add A Student** button. This will save you postage when ordering outside of the free delivery period.

### **2. Free Delivery Period**

All orders placed before the "free delivery" period expires, will be dispatched to your school for your child to bring home. PhotoSmart gives a free delivery period of 3 weeks from the date of the Unique Password being dispatched to the school. When you login you will see a countdown with the amount of days remaining for free delivery.

### **3. When the Free Delivery Period Expires?**

You still have plenty of time to order your photos after the Free Delivery Period Expires. PhotoSmart keeps your images online for a minimum of 12months before being archived. A \$6.00 postage & packaging fee will be applied automatically.

### **4. Who Else Can See My Childs Photos?**

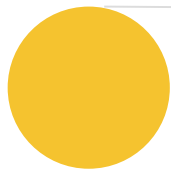
A unique password is created for each individual child, this enables only you to view your child's individual portrait and class, or groups photos associated to your child.
