Kai ora Whanau,

This week you will receive your child's preliminary report. This is an opportunity for you to see how your child has settled into Rosehill Intermediate, and for you to give us some feedback. We really appreciate you taking the time to complete this.

Rosehill Intermediate has always focused on literacy and numeracy and will remain to do so. You will see from your child's roopu newsletter what your child is covering in their class in Maths, Writing and Reading. 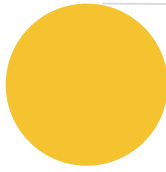
