### News from the Board

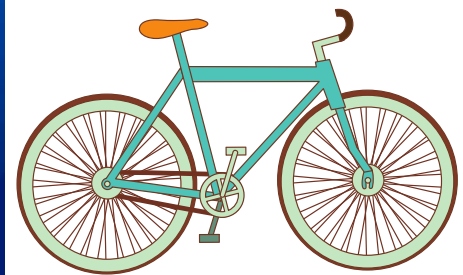
It is fantastic to see so many students biking to school this year.
