Another hint for helping your child develop their COLLABORATIVE attribute

TEACH THEM TO TAKE TURNS!!

Teaching children to work and listen to others takes time and support from adults. Children should be encouraged to take turns and share information and opinions, so they learn to value others and themselves.

Simple activities that have children 'pulling' their actions together by working on different parts of the same task is a good place to start, eg. preparing the evening meal, someone could peel the potatoes, someone could set the table, some could cook the meat etc. Then you can move onto having your children co-operate positively where they are able to share with each other what they know and why they think things are the way they are. This can also help them problem solve so they reach a solution together eg. when shall we cook the meat so that it is cooked at the same time as the potatoes? etc.
